Scholarship Award

Purpose: *To assist two Monrovia High School graduates further their education in a post-secondary school.*

The Monrovia Festival and Civic Association will fund Two (2) Scholarships for \$1,000 each.

Qualifications:

1. Student must be a graduating senior who has been a resident of Monroe and/or Gregg townships for at least 2 years.
2. Student must submit their high school transcripts and must be ranked in the upper 50% of their graduating class.
3. Student must be accepted by an accredited college, trade, business or technical school.
4. Student must exhibit a strong desire to further their education and show initiative, responsibility, citizenship, and good moral character.

Application:

1. A student interested in applying for this scholarship must complete an application form and return it along with their transcripts to the senior counselor in charge of scholarships no later than 7:30 am, _____
2. Each applicant must furnish and attach a signed letter of recommendation from a mentor of their choice. E.g. (teacher, employer, pastor, advisor)

Scholarship Committee:

The current scholarship committee of The Monrovia Festival and Civic Association shall determine the two (2) graduating seniors who will be awarded the scholarships. One (1) alternative graduating senior will also be chosen to receive the award if the other candidates are unable to qualify for or use the award.

The committee will take into consideration a student's:

1. Responses to the application
2. Overall grade point average in high school or vocational school.
3. Financial need
4. Recommendation letter from the student's mentor.
5. Community Activities

Payment and Recognition

1. **Recognition:** A certificate will be presented to each of the two (2) award-winning and one (1) alternative graduating seniors at the Honor Day Program by a member of The Monrovia Festival and Civic Association or their representative.
2. **Payment:** Payment will be made after the student provides the Monrovia Festival and Civic Association with grade transcripts from two(2) completed college, trade, business, or technical school semesters. The student must have maintained a C average or greater (or the equivalent thereof).

THIS SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE PAID TO ASSIST THE STUDENT IN THEIR SECOND YEAR OF SCHOOLING.

If the awarded seniors cannot meet the requirements stated above or for any reason cannot use the award, they must notify the scholarship committee by July 1 in the summer following the completion of year number one so that payment may be made to the alternate.
